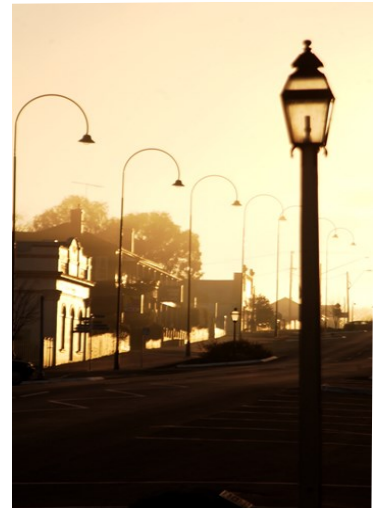

History & Heritage

McCrossin's Mill Museum, Gallery and Function Centre - 31 Salisbury Street

This imposing three-storey flour mill, saved from demolition by the Uralla Historical Society, now houses exhibits of national significance, including the Thunderbolt Story and a Chinese Joss House and other artifacts from the Rocky River Goldfields. Rock Hunter's Rendezvous - 104 Bridge Street

On permanent display at the Visitor Information Centre, is a remarkable collection of minerals and gemstones. Collected over many years by local resident and rock hunter extraordinaire, the late Harry Wooldridge, the exhibit contains many fine examples of local gemstones and minerals, as well as samples from much further afield.

Uralla Foundry Museum - Cnr Salisbury & East Streets
